Discuss and Consider Approval (Kris Miller)

- Job and Family Services: A Resolution approving an Agreement with A.V.O. Behavioral Health, LLC for Family Peer Mentor Services for the Ohio START (Sobriety, Treatment, and Reducing Trauma) program.
This Agreement will provide peer support to parents who participate in the Ohio START program with their path to recovery from addiction. It will run from July 1, 2026, and continue through June 30, 2027. The total amount of the agreement shall not exceed Fifty-Nine Thousand Dollars (\$59,000.00) during the term of the agreement.
- Job and Family Services: A Resolution approving an agreement with Rosalind Caro, Amber Dudsak, Marion Foster, Janeen Gordon, Beth Kiggans, Renee Lewis, Paige Mintz, Melanie Montgomery, and Julie Vince to conduct Foster and Adoptive Home Studies and Large Family Assessments.
These agreements will not exceed \$35,000.00 each and will run from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2028.

- A Resolution Approving Stark County Engineer's Revised Fee Schedule for Right-of-Way Permits Issued for Work within County Road Rights-of-Way.
The proposed Resolution updates the existing fee schedule established by Resolution dated February 10, 2000. The revised schedule reflects the administrative costs associated with processing and managing permits, including plan review, permit administration, and site inspections. The Engineer's Office has listened to and considered concerns raised by utility companies during the review process and has incorporated adjustments to address those concerns where appropriate. The Engineer remains committed to maintaining a collaborative relationship with utility providers and will continue to work directly with industry representatives. To support ongoing coordination, the Engineer's Office will continue to host two to three in-person meetings annually with utility stakeholders to discuss upcoming projects, operational concerns, and opportunities for improved communication and cooperation.
- A Resolution approving and accepting of a Standard Highway Easement from Tack Enterprises, LLC for the reconstruction of a Bridge (CA-15-28) crossing Central Ave. SE.
The County Engineer is requesting the Board of Commissioner to approve and accept a Standard Highway easement to reconstruct a Bridge (CA-15-28) crossing Central Ave. SE. The property owner, Tack Enterprises, LLC, will be compensated \$5,000.00 for the permanent easement.

Commissioners (Sarah Birone for Jennifer Odey)

- A Resolution Authorizing the Execution of the Preliminary Agreement and Joinder Agreement for the Funding of the Addison Lake LLC Sewer and Water Extension Project

- A Resolution accepting a Proposal Contract from Premier Fence and Deck to erect a fence and gates at the Mount Pleasant Storm Water Detention Basin in Plain Township.

Three quotes were received for the requested work for the Muont Pleasant Detention Basin Fence project. It is recommended the purchase of materials and services be awarded to Premier Fence and Decks of Sugarcreek, Ohio. Their quoted price is \$71,800.00. The final proposed fence will be five foot high, black, vinyl coated chain link fence and posts. In the northeast and northwest corners, there will be a twenty four foot double swinging gate. In the southeast corner there will be a sliding thirty foot gate. These gates will allow access for the sanitary sewer maintenance on all sides of the property and will allow for maintenance and mowing throughout the property.

- A Resolution clarifying the existing HOME Consortium Agreement between Stark County and the cities of Alliance and Massillon.

In 2014, Stark County and the cities of Alliance and Massillon entered into a HOME Consortium agreement which contains auto renewal provisions for successive three-year periods. HUD has requested an addendum be executed to clarify that the existing HOME Consortium agreement will cover the FY 2027-2029 period, automatically renewing for successive qualifications periods of three federal fiscal years each.

- A Resolution, on behalf of the Stark County Sheriff's Office, to submit the FY2025 Body-Worn Camera Policy & Implementation Program Grant Application, O-BJA-2025-172461.

The Board is requested to approve the Sheriff to submit the FY 2025 Body-Worn Camera Policy & Implementation Program Grant Application, O-BJA-2025-172461, and authorize the President of the Board to sign the Certification as Chief Executive Officer of the Applicant Government.

- A Resolution, on behalf of Family Court, approving an Agreement with Belmont Pines Hospital for the custody, care and provision of protective services for delinquent children.

The contract term will be from July 1, 2026, through March 31, 2027.

- A Resolution reappointing Melinda Chase to serve on the Board of Building Appeals for Stark County.

The Board of Building Appeals is recommending the Board of Commissioners reappoint Melinda Chase to an additional five-year term, running from August 1, 2026 to July 31, 2031.
